### What does PBI do?

PBI has been working to support human rights and promote non-violence for 25 years. We send teams of international observers to areas of conflict and repression, to provide protective accompaniment to local human rights defenders whose lives and work are under threat. Our work is based on principles of non-partisanship and non-interference, in the belief that lasting transformation of violent conflict cannot be imposed from outside but must be based on the capacity of local people to build a genuine peace. We act only at the express request of local people and it is they who determine where our assistance is most needed.

PBI UK, one of 17 country groups around Europe, North America and the Pacific, is responsible for the vital support work which allows the field programmes - in Colombia, Mexico, Indonesia, Nepal and Guatemala - to operate smoothly. Its main areas of work are political support building, recruitment and training of volunteers, outreach and publicity, and fundraising.
