

## **Naming (Peace Brigades International—USA) in Your Estate Plans**

### **Sample Bequest Language\***

Including Peace Brigades International-USA in your estate plans is a very simple procedure. A bequest is, in fact, the simplest form of planned gift and one that is very attractive for many people who want to support for years to come.

A bequest may be in the form of cash, securities, real estate, an insurance policy, or other property. Simple language for including The Peace Brigades International-USA in your estate plans is provided below.

*Specific Bequest:* A gift through your estate for a specific amount of cash or property.

*Percentage Bequest:* A gift of a percent of an estate.

*I devise and bequeath to Peace Brigades International-USA, a non-profit organization located at 1326 9<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington, DC 20001 \_\_\_\_\_ percent of my estate to be used for the work and educational programming of Peace Brigades International-USA as determined by the PBI-USA National Coordinating Committee, NCC.*

*Residual Bequest:* A gift of whatever is left of an estate after other distributions.

*I devise and bequeath to Peace Brigades International-USA, a non-profit organization located at 1326 9<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington, DC 20001, \_\_\_\_\_ (enter the word "all" or a percentage) of the rest of my estate, of whatever kind and wherever situated, to be used for the work and educational program of Peace Brigades International-USA, as determined by the PBI-USA National Coordinating Committee, NCC.*
